The complete text of the Minutes, Resolutions, and Policies are on file at the Stanton Community Schools Superintendent's Office and are available for public inspection during regular business hours. Availability of the agenda was communicated in an advertised notice and current copy of the agenda was maintained as stated in the notice. All proceedings of the Board of Education, except as may be hereinafter noted, were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public. Abbreviations: AMPVF- All members present voted for, MC- Motion carried.

A regular meeting of the Stanton Community Schools Board of Education was convened in open and public session on Monday, March 9, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. in the High/Middle School Library at the Stanton Community High School, 1007 Kingwood, Stanton, Nebraska. The meeting was called to order by President John Mandl.

Roll call was taken, and the following board members were present: Wendy Benson, Colleen Butterfield, Sarah Klinetobe, John Mandl, Shad Pohlman, and Tim Reese. Also present were Michael Sieh, Sarah Remm, and David Cunningham.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all present. President John Mandl announced the location and informed the public of the current copy of the Open Meetings Act posted in the Library meeting room.

Motion was made by Sarah Klinetobe, seconded by Colleen Butterfield to declare the meeting open and properly published by advance notice in accordance with board policy #8342 with the agenda given to the president of the board and all members prior to the meeting date. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Tim Reese, seconded by Shad Pohlman to approve the board agenda. AMPVF-MC.

Minutes from the February 10, 2020 regular board meeting were approved and accepted by the Secretary.

A public forum was held. A thank you was read. Tracy Kuester-Burtwistle, Teresa Christensen, and Bret Burtwistle addressed the school board concerning volleyball.

Elementary Principal Sarah Remm reported on the elementary parent-teacher conference attendance, reviewed the plans for Science & Social Studies curriculum development, discussed planning for summer school, presented scores from the NDE preschool observation, and listed the staff attended workshops & trainings.

Secondary Principal David Cunningham requested approval of the contract for a Life Sciences instructor, presented the state wrestling qualifiers and wrestling coaches for recognition, presented the annual activity comprehensive report, discussed the quotes for the track renovation, and reported on the secondary parent-teacher conference attendance.

The Superintendent's report included Head of Operations, Russ Johnson, who presented his semiannual report to the board. Superintendent Michael Sieh discussed classified staff and administrative salaries, reviewed the monthly bills, presented the 2020-2021 school calendar for adoption, and recommended names for appointment to the Stanton Community Schools Foundation Board of Directors.

Motion was made by Shad Pohlman, seconded by Sarah Klinetobe to approve the contract between John Schmidt and the School District for the position of 7-12 Life Science Instructor for the 2020-2021 school year. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Tim Reese, seconded by Colleen Butterfield to congratulate Issiah Borgmann for qualifying & placing 6th and Sutton Pohlman for qualifying for State Wrestling and their coaches, Randy Hansen & Kenny Wurdinger. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Wendy Benson, seconded by Sarah Klinetobe to approve the Activities School Improvement Action Plan. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Shad Pohlman, seconded by Tim Reese to accept the track bid from Midwest Tennis and Track, in the amount of \$127,575.00. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Wendy Benson, seconded by Colleen Butterfield to approve the classified staff salary schedule, and contracts between Stanton Community Schools and Jeanette Davidson for the position of Food Director with an annual base salary of \$39,300.00 and Russ Johnson for the position of Head of Operations with an annual base salary of \$61,125.00, for the 2020-2021 school year. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Colleen Butterfield, seconded by Sarah Klinetobe to adopt the 2020-2021 school calendar. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Wendy Benson, seconded by Shad Pohlman to appoint John Eberly and Lisa Wilke to the Stanton Community Schools Foundation Board of Directors for a three-year term. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by John Mandl, seconded by Tim Reese to a) approve & authorize payment of District #3 bills presented at this meeting; b) accept the Activity Account Reports; c) accept the Treasurer's Report; d) accept the Account Summary Report; and e) accept the Revenue Report. AMPVF-MC.

The next regular monthly meeting will be April 13, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. in the High School /Middle School Library. Board retreat will be on March 11, 2020 starting at 6:30 p.m. at Geno's Steakhouse in Wayne, NE. The meeting was duly adjourned at 8:50 p.m.
