Availability of the agenda was communicated in an advertised notice and a current copy of the agenda was maintained as stated in the notice. All proceedings of the Board of Education, except as may be hereinafter noted, were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public. Abbreviations: AMPVF- All members present voted for, MC- Motion carried.

A regular meeting of the Stanton Community Schools Board of Education was convened in open and public session on Monday, August 10, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. in the High/Middle School Library at the Stanton Community High School, 1007 Kingwood, Stanton, Nebraska. The meeting was called to order by President John Mandl.

Roll call was taken, and the following board members were present: Sarah Klinetobe, Colleen Butterfield, Wendy Benson, John Mandl, Shad Pohlman and Tim Reese. Also present were Darren Soucie, David Cunningham, and Sarah Remm.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all present. President John Mandl announced the location and informed the public of the current copy of the Open Meetings Act posted in the Library meeting room.

Motion was made by Shad Pohlman, seconded by Colleen Butterfield to declare the meeting open and properly published by advance notice in accordance with board policy #8342 with the agenda given to the president of the board and all members prior to the meeting date. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Sarah Klinetobe, seconded by Tim Reese to approve the board agenda. AMPVF-MC.

Minutes from the July 13, 2020 regular board meeting were approved and accepted by the Secretary.

A public forum was held.

Elementary Principal Sarah Remm reported on Kindergarten Roundup and on the Preschool-Parent Orientation; presented beginning-of-school information; reported on summer school; and discussed additional classroom support needs.

Secondary Principal David Cunningham presented a volunteer coaching contract; announced the start-of-fall activities; and reviewed the 2020 NSAA fall season guidelines and the Stanton Community Schools Covid-19 activities guidelines.

Superintendent Darren Soucie updated the board on summer projects, discussed budget strategies, reported on end-of-year transfers, presented several board policies for second reading, and discussed upcoming conferences.

Motion was made by Shad Pohlman, seconded by Colleen Butterfield, to approve the volunteer coaching contract, for volleyball, between the school district and Rachel Kaup. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Sarah Klinetobe, seconded by Wendy Benson to transfer \$50,000 from the General Fund to the Hot Lunch Fund. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Colleen Butterfield, seconded by Tim Reese to transfer \$25,000 from the General Fund to the Activity Fund. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Shad Pohlman, seconded by Tim Reese to transfer \$50,000 for future track repair from the General Fund to the Depreciation Fund. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made Sarah Klinetobe, seconded by Colleen Butterfield to approve the second reading of board policies #1040, 1500, 1501, 5101, 5103, 5406, 5506, 6111 & 6117. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Wendy Benson, seconded by Tim Reese to a) approve & authorize payment for District #3 bills presented at this meeting; b) accept the Activity Account Report; c) accept the Treasurer's Report; d) accept the Account Summary Report; and e) accept the of Revenue Report. AMPVF-MC.

The next regular monthly meeting will be September 14, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. in the High School /Middle School Library.

The meeting was duly adjourned at 7:46 p.m.
